



Eadweard Muybridge

- Photography is so advanced now that it can capture moments the human eye cannot! - used a “zoopraxiscope”
- Cameras snap shots at evenly-spaced points in time – effect of things happening in a sequence
- Motion studies like this one inspired the creation of moving pictures (movies)
- Great influence on painters like Degas, Eakins, Duchamp, and Boccioni (could photograph their subjects)



In a conscious rejection of Western civilization Paul Gauguin emigrated to Tahiti and came after a two and a half months long voyage on 9 June 1891 in the capital Papeete.

The Polynesian mythology, the sight of young Polynesian inspired him while dozens of paintings, but his expectation of finding in the South Seas paradise lost, was not fulfilled. Frustrated and destitute traveled Paul Gauguin June 4 bis August 30, 1893 back to France.

















Founders Charles Zidler and Joseph Oller purchased a giant stucco elephant they had seen exhibited at the Paris Universal Exhibition of 1889. At the Moulin Rouge, the elephant served as a luxurious opium den where for a single franc, gentlemen could enter by way of a spiral staircase inside the leg and be entertained by belly dancers (inside the belly of the beast).













1884-1886, oil on canvas



La Grande Jatte, 1884







Georges Seurat, Study for "Les Poseuses" »
